8 Things We Must Do to Receive the Blessings of God

1. We Must Pray _____

"They continually met together to pray as a group with one purpose in mind.....". Acts 1:14

"When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a noise like strong, blowing wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw something that looked like flames of fire that were separated and stood over each person there. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and they began to speak different languages by the power the Holy Spirit was giving them." Acts 2:1-3 (ESV)

2. We Must Use _____

6. We Must Worship _____

"They continued to worship together in the temple courts... praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people." Acts 2:46, 47

7. We Must Be Willing _____

"All the believers shared everything with each other. They would sell their land and the things they owned and then give the money to anyone who needed it." Acts 2:44, 45

8. We Must Bring _____

"Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand people were added to their number that day!" Acts 2:40, 41
