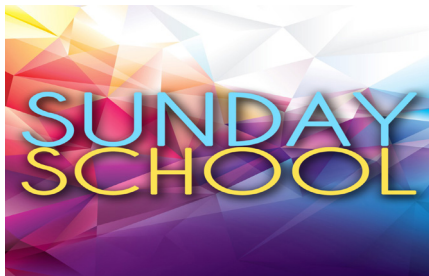

2 Chronicles 20:22-24 (ESV) ²² *And when they began to sing and praise, the LORD set an ambush against the men of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah, so that they were routed. ²³ For the men of Ammon and Moab rose against the inhabitants of Mount Seir, devoting them to destruction, and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, they all helped to destroy one another. ²⁴ When Judah came to the watchtower of the wilderness, they looked toward the horde, and behold, there were dead bodies lying on the ground; none had escaped.*

2 Chronicles 20:25 (ESV) ²⁵ *When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take their spoil, they found among them, in great numbers, goods, clothing, and precious things, which they took for themselves until they could carry no more. They were three days in taking the spoil, it was so much.*

2 Chronicles 20:27 (ESV) ²⁷ *Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat at their head, returning to Jerusalem with joy, for the LORD had made them rejoice over their enemies.*

2 Chronicles 20:29 (ESV) ²⁹ *And the fear of God came on all the kingdoms of the countries when they heard that the LORD had fought against the enemies of Israel.*

2 Chronicles 20:30 (ESV) ³⁰ *So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet, for his God gave him rest all around.*
